These traineeships provide an opportunity for motivated individuals to start a career in the clerical field. Trainees develop word processing, computing and general office skills pertinent to the Level 2 or 3 of their traineeship.

Certificate III – Mechanical Welding

This apprenticeship is designed to provide a comprehensive practical and theoretical base that enables the development of fabrication skills, technical procedures and concepts, as well as develop safe working practices. Applicants must have completed year 11 or have undertaken a pre-vocational training program in a similar area to this trade.

Certificate III – Mechanical Fitting

Mechanical Fitters carry out repairs and maintenance to a wide range of mechanical equipment such as pumps, hydraulic and pneumatic systems, compressors, and a wide range of mechanical components. Applicants must have completed year 11 or have undertaken a pre-vocational training program in a similar area to this trade

Certificate III in Automotive Technician

This is a training program that leads to the completion of the Automotive Industry Retail, Service and Repair Training package AUR99 qualification AUR31099. This qualification is designed to reflect the role of employees who perform a range of skilled operations in the industry sector with the need to apply discretion and judgment and some multi skilling. Minimum requirement year 10.

Certificate III – Electrical Mechanics

Electrical/Instrumentation fitters are mainly engaged in maintaining, repairing and installing a wide range of electrical and instrumentation equipment within the mining industry. Applicants must have completed year 11 or have undertaken a pre-vocational training program in a similar area to this trade.
