Early Career Teachers – Year 2 of the program

This program invites early career teachers to develop leadership skills both inside and outside the classroom. Focusing on Leading in Action, the second year of AISWA's Early Career Teacher program provides new educators the opportunity to take on new leadership roles in their schools. This type of program recognises that leadership in education goes beyond just classroom teaching and includes roles like mentoring, curriculum development, and school improvement initiatives.

Aspiring Leaders

This program consists of four scoped and sequenced modules that develop the knowledge, skills, and understandings of identified educators who wish to pursue promotional positions in AISWA schools. The modules are: Leadership today for tomorrow, Communication and relationships, Strategy, negotiation and influence, Gauging impact for improvement.

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Middle Leaders

The 2024 Middle Leaders Program is a practical, highly interactive, and evidence-based program that stretches emerging leaders to the next stage of their personal and professional growth in school leadership. The program consists of four modules and is supported by guest speakers who invite participants on a journey of collaboration, exploration and reflection.

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New Principals and Executive Team Network

This Network is for AISWA Principals who are in the early stages of their role and/or those who are experienced Principals, but new to Western Australia. It is intended that you will be able to serve as a resource for one another and share questions and discoveries. We will meet each term to discuss and share solutions to current issues and questions.

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Positive Workplaces

This program brings together research from the positive psychology field blended with teachings on cultural norms and experiences of rich workplace cultures. It is open to anyone who is interested in building a joyful workplace culture through a process of inclusion, engagement, and well-being. Participants will explore how they position themselves and others in the workplace, and how the latest research in neuro leadership can assist in building an inclusive and thriving workplace culture.

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National Certification Project (HALT)

Are you a highly effective and skilled classroom practitioner who regularly guides advises or leads others? Come and join a group of like-minded colleagues as you support one another to evidence your practice and achieve National Certification as a Highly Accomplished or Lead teacher. We will meet four times during the year, to help build your collection of evidence demonstrating the impact you have on others.

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Women In Educational Leadership Network

The afternoon network meetings are for anyone interested in gender equality and the role of women in leadership roles across varying industries. Each event will be tailored to a specific theme with a guest speaker and/or 2-3 panelists to share their stories.

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
