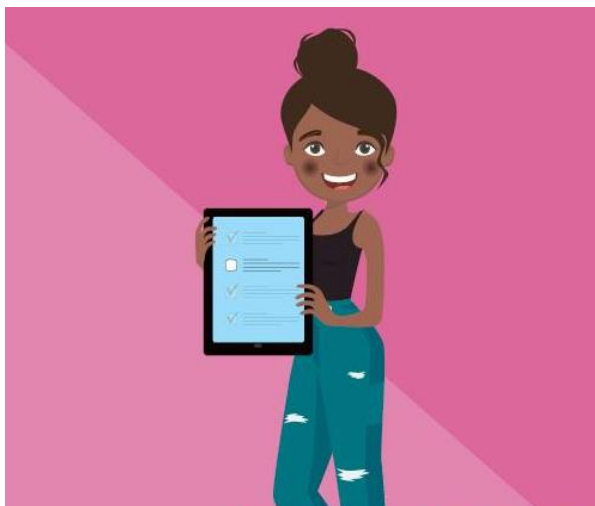

Fuel your future after high school

Find out what support you can get from Centrelink to help steer you to success.

Whatever adventure you're going on after school, you'll want to be ready for the journey. Just like the scouts say, it pays to be prepared.

Centrelink has [payments for students and trainees](#) to help you with the costs of doing uni, TAFE or an apprenticeship.

If you're doing full-time study or an Australian Apprenticeship, you might get [Youth Allowance as a student](#). If you're an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander student or full-time Australian Apprentice, you might get [ABSTUDY](#).

If you're looking for work after school, maybe including part-time study, you might get [Youth Allowance as a job seeker](#).

See what payments and services you can get using the [Payment and Service Finder](#). You can even get an estimate of how much your fortnightly payment could be. To get an estimate, you'll need to enter in information like your parents' income and where you'll be living.

Even if you're not quite sure what course you'll do next year, apply early. You can apply up to 13 weeks before your course starts. This way you're more likely to have your payment when you need it.

Getting through your last year of school and taking that next big step can be stressful. If you're struggling or want to speak to someone, you can contact [headspace](#). They have mental and physical health support for young people. You can also use the [Payment and Service Finder](#) to find services in your area.

Ask your questions on Facebook

If you have questions about your eligibility and how to claim, you can ask Services Australia online. Connect with Student Update on [Facebook](#) or [Twitter](#). You can ask questions and stay up to date on what's happening.

Keep in mind, you shouldn't share personal details in a public space like social media.

You can also subscribe to get email updates on the latest [news for students and trainees](#) delivered to your inbox. You get the information that affects you while you're getting a payment.

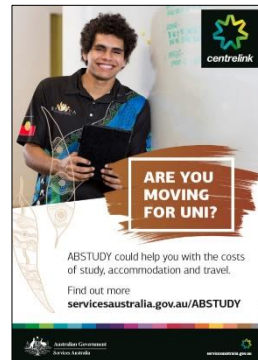
