WHO ARE WE?

Scribblers Festival is a Literature and Arts Festival for Young People brought to you by cultural non-profit FORM with the Town of Claremont

From 8–12 May 2019, Scribblers Festival will bring authors and illustrators from all over the world to celebrate storytelling, writing, illustration and creativity with Western Australian students, teachers, and children of all ages.

WHY BE A YOUTH CURATOR?

The YA Collective is a brand new initiative that dedicates a day for teenagers to talk about the books and topics that are relevant to them. Scribblers Festival is on the hunt for energetic curators to help us shape this day – as part of the team you'll have the opportunity to leave your mark on this inaugural program.

As a Scribblers Festival Youth Curator you'll get to meet the incredible guests attending the 2019 Festival, including Renee Watson, Celine Kiernan, Neal Shusterman, Zoe Norton Lodge, Tomi Adeyemi, Sha'an d'Anthes, AJ Betts and many more.

You'll also receive a backstage pass to the Festival Green Room, a profile on our blog and a book pack to take home and add to your book collection.

So, if you're passionate about the arts, literature and programming, this is your chance to gain skills and experience in a fun and supportive Festival environment.

WHAT'S INVOLVED?

As a Youth Curator you will work within a team to shape the sessions that will form the program for The YA Collective.

You will also attend *The YA Collective* on Saturday 11 May for the opportunity to get some hands-on event experience. The team of Youth Curators will be active onstage and also behind the scenes to make sure the events run smoothly. Across the day you will have the opportunity to take on the following roles:

PRODUCER – Oversees the Festival sessions. This includes stage management and time keeping.

HOST – Introduces the presenters to the audience and manages audience questions.

ARTIST LIAISON – Will make sure all presenters arrive to their session on time and have everything they need.

REVIEWER – You will be sitting front row in the sessions documenting the event on social media.

PRE-FESTIVAL TRAINING

The team of Youth Curators will participate in a fun training workshop with a mentor at The Goods Shed in Claremont on Saturday 12 January 2019 from 10am – 2pm.

In this workshop you will:

- · Design and format the sessions
- · Schedule the sessions
- · Determine production requirements
- · Determine your individual role for the sessions

Submissions must be no more than 2 A4 pages and must be submitted via email in .doc or .pdf format.

Submissions must be received by COB Friday 23 November 2018. Applicants will be notified of the decision by the 30 November 2018.

Don't forget to attach your completed permission form signed by your parent/guardian. Submissions received without a completed permission form will be deemed ineligible.

To be considered, you must:

- be 13-16 years of age
- · live in Western Australia if you live in regional areas, you must be able to travel to Perth
- be available on the dates below and be able to commit to the workload (pre-reading etc)

- · must be able to attend the workshop session on Saturday 12 January 2019, 10am to 2pm
- · must be able to attend Scribblers Festival on Saturday 11 May 2019 for The YA Collective
