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The Association of Independent Schools of Western Australia (AISWA) welcomes the agreement with the Australian Government on the phased introduction of a new model for calculating government funding for non-government schools that creates a foundation for a fair, reasonable and enduring resolution of the funding issue.

Ms Gould, Executive Director of AISWA, welcomed the government's support for parental choice. "There is of course much more detailed work to be done on complex technical issues before the new model can be fully implemented in a phased process over ten years," she said.

AISWA and other representatives of Independent schools will continue to work closely with Department officials on this work.
