

# DijiRed Ltd

We are a registered not-for-profit organisation whose main purpose is the benevolent relief of people in need while recycling e-waste.

Our charitable objectives are to:

- Advance social and public welfare
- Advance education
- Advance the environment by reducing e-waste

DijiRed does this by providing refurbished digital equipment to:

- Students from low socio-economic backgrounds
- The disadvantaged
- Indigenous people
- Youth and adults in temporary accommodation or newly homed
- Differently abled people
- People experiencing domestic violence
- Refugees and asylum seekers attending English classes or other training remotely

Digital equipment is allocated for the purpose education, job seeking, reducing isolation and advancing mental health. Our organisation works with various charities and government departments to reach those who need a hand.

Broken or unsalvageable equipment is processed further for parts to further reduce e-waste.

## Our Vision

To assist in providing equal opportunity in education by means of equal access to digital technology for all in Australia.

## Our Mission

Our purpose is to:

- Reduce e-waste by repairing, refurbishing and reusing digital equipment
- Support local communities by providing digital equipment to students from low socioeconomic backgrounds for education purposes
- Support local communities to upskill and improve digital literacy, reduce isolation and setting up of digital hubs for communities

# Laptops for Students and Computers for Communities Initiatives

## DijiRed has two initiatives:

Laptops for Students started in response to COVID-19 in March 2020 to meet the immediate need for online schooling that was out of reach for many Western Australians.

The initiative has since grown and helped over 150 families obtain digital equipment and rescued a multitude of laptops and computers destined for landfill. Rescued digital equipment has been repaired, refurbished and given a new lease of life while helping the community.

Computers for Communities assists charitable organisations and other community hubs in Perth, and more recently regional and remote areas of Western Australia, to get shared access to digital technology.

Our next goal is to upskill volunteers to assist us with repairing and refurbish the equipment.

# How you can help

Individuals and companies can donate their unneeded laptops, tablets, and computers and be part of this cause. An ongoing commitment from companies or organisations to supply all or a portion of their digital equipment to DijiRed will ensure a sustainable model and continuity of our service. Only by working together can this be successful.

Most companies continuously refresh their IT equipment, most on a three year cycle, and an ongoing supply of the old equipment refurbished and repurposed will assist in bridging the gap to equal access to digital technology.

# Security

Security is our first priority. Our processes ensure data is always handled in a safe and secure manner and organisations do not need to ensure devices are wiped before being donated. All equipment is transported securely and stored in a secure location. Data is wiped using the highest standard of care. Data storage devices are sanitised of data using the Australian ISM-6.2.93 standard approved for software based data destruction. Any devices that are damaged or run an unsupported interface are physically destroyed to the point of being unrecoverable.
