Workshops – these can include but are not limited to:

- Play is the way: Socio-dramatic play (3-8 years)
- Play watching: Who are the Master Players? (3-8 years)
- Promoting literacy and numeracy through play (3-8 years)
- Documentation and play: How will we know what children are learning? (3-8 years)
- Story-telling and story-acting (3-5 year olds)
- Drama: A powerful learning medium for all ages (3-8 years)
- Children's drawing and painting: Graphic exploration that is playful (3-8 years)
- Tinkering as a way of inquiring: designed particularly with boys in mind! (3-8 years)
- Exploration of materials and ideas in science and mathematics (3-8 years)
- Browsing and viewing leading to reading and writing (3-8 years)

Two day workshop

Ways to Learn Through Inquiry: Guiding Children to Deeper Understanding (3-8 years)

This workshop addresses the following questions:

- 1. What can inquiry-based learning look like with children aged 3 to 8 years?
- 2. How can the environment be structured so that children are empowered to learn independently?
- 3. How can a rich tapestry of guided inquiry and the children's spontaneous inquiry be woven together to provide opportunities for children to go deeper in their understanding?

Jo will take us through some of the ways that children inquire, including through:

- Socio-dramatic play
- Read-alouds and responses
- Browsing and viewing leading to reading and writing
- Tinkering
- Exploration of materials and ideas in science and mathematics

Video footage, photographs and other documentation will demonstrate multiple ways of inquiring.

Opportunities for participants to share their practice will be embedded in the workshop so please bring along examples.

- Nature Pedagogy (3-6 year olds)
- Restorative Justice approaches (3-6 year olds)
- Book-making: children as authors, telling their stories through their drawings (3-6 year olds)
