Exploring Creativity for the Teacher as Writer PLUS

Please join the Murdoch School of Education for a FREE seminar and workshop presented by Kevin Price, PhD researcher in creative writing and education at Murdoch University.

In an effective writing pedagogy, the learning writer and the teacher-aswriter team up to produce new experiences for learners, developing skills, understanding and knowledge as a shared, yet individual, resource for both learner and teacher

In this seminar, Kevin Price will discuss a short fictocritical paper (drawn from his PhD research into the role of story and its transformative experience in creative writing practice, study and education), and interrogate the merits of taken-forgranted assumptions in our understanding of creativity in the creative writer, and what it is we aim to produce as evidence of that understanding.

There will also be a short, follow-on workshop that will introduce a dynamic, complementary writing exercise to enhance creativity in the production of writing learning across all genres and forms. The exercise is designed to increase learner confidence, with cognitive skills also expected to improve as a result. Participants will take away a powerful exercise they can use immediately in their classrooms to engage their students.

Kevin Price is a novelist, PhD researcher in creative writing and education at Murdoch University, investigating the role of story and its transformative experience in creative writing practice, study, and teaching. Kevin has worked as a secondary English teacher, advertising creative director and copywriter, a magazine columnist, and a music producer and performer. He is published in Writing in Education National Association of Writers in Education (NAWE), and is the author of Kumakana, A Gronups Tale (2017) and Story Craft: A Born

Storytellers Theory and Teaching Manual (2014).
