Class Clowns is a national development program for young people. It introduces teens aged 14-18 to comedy and uses artistic activities to hone comedic talent and build self-esteem, confidence and resilience.

## **How does Class Clowns work?**

- Teachers, parents or guardians register students to attend a FREE workshop near them (dates and locations overleaf)
- Students develop a 3-5 minute comedy routine as a solo, duo or trio
- Students attend the workshop, where they refine and rehearse their routine with the help of a professional comedian
- 4 Students then have the opportunity to perform their routine after the workshop, in front of a live audience!
- 5 The funniest entrants are selected by guest judges to go through to State Finals.
- State Final winners are invited to participate in the National Grand Final, held during the Melbourne International Comedy Festival.

First prize is \$1,500 and a \$1,000 workshop package for your school!
