Expression of Interest to attend the Australian Government, Department of Education Skills and Employment (DESE) **National Schools Constitutional Convention 2022 is** now open. Eligible students are invited to apply to participate in the National Schools Constitutional Convention 2022.

To be eligible students must be enrolled in Year 10 or 11 in Western Australia, in 2021. Applicants would also be well placed to:

- Have attended the WA State Schools Constitutional Convention 2021, and or
- Provide evidence of participation in extra-curricular events and other academic pursuits.

Application forms must be emailed to the Constitutional Centre, via **cceducation@dpc.wa.gov.au**, by **Sunday the 12h of December 2021**. Submissions received after this date cannot be included in the selection process.

The date and location for the NSCC2022 are still to be confirmed by DESE, however, we expect that this event will take place over three days in Term 1 2022. If possible students will travel to Canberra to attend in person with peers from around the country. If it will not be possible for students to meet in Canberra, we will (subject to health restrictions) bring together a small group of students from Western Australia to the Constitutional Centre in West Perth, to join the convention virtually.
