Information for Regional Schools

We have a great opportunity for 15 **Regional Schools** to participate in a Free Citizen Science Project called Insect Investigators and all regional schools are invited to participate.

Schools who are chosen to be part of the project will run a Malaise Trap in Term 1 2022, which catches flying insects, in an area of native vegetation on or near their school. With the help of scientists, schools will learn about the

insects they catch, and may even discover new species!

Insects collected will be genetically analysed and all results will be communicated back to the schools and students participating.



Scientists will work with

students to name any new species of interest found during the project.
