



# Does your school or child care centre meet the standards for first aid?

**First Aid Training** The assessment will identify the number of staff to be trained in first aid.



Defibrillators

Making defibrillators more accessible can be the difference between life and death. Our specialist will work with you on identifying the best way to achieve this, including training, placement and maintenance.



**First Aid Kits** 

The appropriate number and type of first aid kits for your location will be recommended.



First Aid for Families:

Increase the resilience of your wider community with child-specific first aid sessions for your family groups.

Once your St John Safe assessment has been completed and appropriate training, equipment and systems have implemented, you will then be recognised as being St John Safe You will be presented a certificate to formally recognise your St John Safe endorsement.
