The Diana Award is open to young people aged between 9 and 18 who are campaigning, fundraising and volunteering their way to making a better world, just like Princess Diana. We know that there are many young people in your country who fit this criteria and we believe that they deserve recognition on a global stage.

2017 is a very special year as it marks the 20th Anniversary of Princess Diana's passing. We plan to celebrate Diana's life and legacy throughout the year and as a part of the celebrations we have announced the 'Inaugural Legacy Award' which will look to highlight the achievements of 20 exceptional young people from across the world for their selfless commitment to transforming the lives of others.

Legacy Award recipients will be leaders, visionaries and role models able to inspire and mobilise new generations to serve their communities and make a positive change to the world as Princess Diana believed they could. The 20 recipients of the Legacy Award will travel to London, UK to receive the honour at a prestigious ceremony in May 2017. Legacy Award recipients will also have access to a unique Development Programme which will provide them with the opportunity to enhance their skills in four key areas; leadership, community development, social entrepreneurship and technology for good.
