Yagan Square is a celebration of Western Australian history, lifestyle, landscape and culture in the heart of Perth CBD.

The design of the square reflects the natural landscape of WA – from the unique geology, colours, textures and natural materials; to native wildflowers and the best of WA produce.

There is a strong Aboriginal narrative that runs through the square which incorporates stories from the Whadjuk people – the traditional owners of the land – exploring themes of people, animals, birds and landscape; all of which shape and create a strong sense of place. These stories have influenced various elements of Yagan Square, creating a unique space that is reflective of both culture and history.
