



TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF ENGINEERED FRINGING REEF, CY O'CONNOR FORESHORE



- The erosion reduction reef will be doubling in size as stage two is installed as part of an artificial reef trial off the shore of C.Y. O'Connor Beach in October 2024.
- The artificial reef and the offshore operational area around the reef will be temporarily closed to swimmers, snorkelers, divers and marine vessels from 21 October – 18 November during Term 4.
