

NATIONAL SCHOOLS' CONSTITUTIONAL CONVENTION 2023

Expression of Interest to attend the **National Schools' Constitutional Convention 2023 (NSCC)** are now open. Eligible students are invited to submit an Expression of Interest, to participate in the Australian Government Department of Education (DOE) National Schools' Constitutional Convention 2023. The Convention is facilitated by the National Curriculum Services (NCS).

To be eligible students must be enrolled in Year 10 or Year 11 in Western Australia, during 2022. Applicants would also be well placed to:

- Have attended the Western Australian State Schools' Constitutional Convention 2022, and/or
- Provide evidence of participation in extra-curricular events and other academic pursuits.

Application forms must be emailed to the Constitutional Centre, via cceducation@dpc.wa.gov.au, by **Wednesday 12 October, 2022**. Submissions received after this date cannot be included in the selection process.

The Convention will be held on 21 - 23 March 2023 in Canberra at the Museum of Australian Democracy, with accommodation at the Mantra Macarthur Hotel. Costs associated with flights, accommodation and catering are fully funded by DOE. Participants from Western Australia will need to fly to Canberra on 20 March 2023. The NSCC is an annual peak event exploring the Australian Constitution for senior school students in Years 11 and Year 12. A total of 15 student delegates will be selected to attend from Western Australia.
