

Learning Support Teacher – High School PERTH WALDORF SCHOOL

Job Description

Have knowledge of the school ethos and Steiner curriculum.

Be able and willing to help teachers modify class programmes to support children's learning.

Run assessments and write up programmes for children identified by teachers as needing support.

Provide 1:1 support for specific skill development. Meet with and report back to class teachers on progress made.

Provide regular sessions for small groups of students with similar needs.

Set up, run and help teachers to support programmes targeted to student needs.

Write up Individual Education Plans (IEPs) for children.

Meet with or call parents regularly to provide IEPs and feedback on how the children are progressing.

Write semester reports to parents.

Advise assistants on how they can best support the needs of the students.

Ensure staff are aware of students' entitlements to extra time etc in assessments.

Report periodically to the Curriculum Coordinator on the Learning Support program.

Compile the necessary documentation for funding applications.

Selection Criteria

- Hold teacher's registration or be eligible for registration.
- Hold appropriate qualifications or experience to enable you to identify and support high school age students in need.
- Willingness to adopt the Steiner pedagogy and philosophy
- Demonstrate a passion and enthusiasm for education
- Ability to work in partnership with teachers and parents.
- Excellent communication and liaison skills.
- Show adaptability to a dynamic work function and environment
- Hold or obtain Working with Children Check
