An exciting opportunity exists for a capable and passionate leader to take on the role of Principal of Yallingup Steiner School, commencing Monday 20 July 2020.

Yallingup is a well-established, vibrant independent Steiner school situated on Wadandi country, three hours south of Perth. The school is managed collaboratively in a republican spirit by a Principal, a Business Manager and a Finance Manager, a College of Teachers and a School Council – a dynamic and capable group of community members. All those in positions of authority are called upon to aspire to a spirit of service inspired by ideals of inclusivity, the cultivation of the individual and care for the collective 'good'.

Yallingup offers classes from Kindergarten to Class 6 and has a school population of around 110 students. Our location allows us to take advantage of the South West Cape's recreational beaches, wild coastlines, forests and indigenous cultural sites.

The Principal works closely with the Business Manager, Finance Manager and the College of Teachers, liaising between them and the School Council. The Principal is also ultimately responsible for all day-today operations of the school and communications with the school community. This includes implementation of the school's Steiner educational programs based on the Australian Steiner Curriculum Framework. Implementation of the financial and strategic goals, ensuring the development of and adherence to policies, procedures, consistent with good governance and compliant with all State and Federal legislation, standards and regulations, which schools are subject to.
