As a Class 1 Teacher at PWS, you will embark on a rewarding journey guiding children through their formative years with warmth, creativity, and purpose. You will create a nurturing classroom environment and implement a rich curriculum that integrates academics, arts, and practical skills.

A desire to learn more and grow as a teacher is essential and the school will support you in developing your knowledge and skills in Steiner Education. Creativity, artistic ability and musical skills, or the willingness to develop these, are highly desired.
