ABOUT THE ROLE

Our growing three campuses are currently looking for Teachers in their first 5 years of teaching to join our team as soon as possible. The role is highly diverse and very hands-on and requires utmost flexibility, patience and understanding when dealing with students, staff, and parents.

The successful candidate will have:

- capacity to teach literacy and/or numeracy to students who are academically several years behind their peers
- ability to teach young people who are either disengaged or at risk of disengaging from school
- capacity to use trauma-informed practice and techniques
- the ability to be very flexible in the management and/or delivery of support to students

- current registration with TRBWA (or eligibility to be)
- Up to 5 years experience in teaching Secondary Education

Candidates will be highly regarded if they have:

- additional training/qualifications/experience related to working with students that have specific learning disabilities and/or communication disorders (e.g. dyslexia or dysgraphia)
- capacity to teach across multiple content areas
- an awareness of the Berry Street Education Model
- LR/MR (bus) License
