1. Since September 2005, the Chinese Cricket Association has conducted eight coaching/umpiring training courses with assistance from the Asian Cricket Council. The sport is now played in nine cities in China, namely Beijing, Shanghai, Shenyang, Dalian, Guangzhou, Shenzhen, Chongqing, Tianjin and Jinan. More than 150 schools have been involved. 2. It is exciting to know that some people in China are actually playing cricket. However, the reality is that most people in China have never heard of cricket, and have no idea how the game is played.
3. Your task to prepare a simple presentation, by yourself or with a partner, explaining how cricket is played and a few interesting facts about the game. Prepare the presentation with the use of a dictionary, the word list included and pictures and diagrams (from other sources or drawn by yourself).

4. It will be difficult to find many of the terms used in Cricket in Chinese. Most dictionaries will not have them. But this is a good exercise for you to use the words that you have to explain the meaning that you want to get across. Something you will have to do a lot of as your Chinese slowly improves. So, do not worry if you do not have the exact terms that you use in English. Instead explain the idea behind these terms with the words you have at your disposal. Good luck!
5. Once your teacher has checked the draft of your presentation, practice it and then perform it for your teacher or class and/or record it audio-visually.
